

The "Haus Raiffeisen" in St. Johann impresses with its contemporary façade and high-quality furnishings. The interiors also impress with their modern design: solid wooden ceilings made of KLH® – CLT and floor-to-ceiling windows create an inviting ambience. The flats are equipped with elegant kitchens and high-quality materials that ensure comfort and style. The centrally located rental flats are almost fully occupied, which underlines the high demand and popularity of this project.
