

The Montpelier Community Nursery, located in Kentish Town, provides voluntary sector affordable childcare for 2-5 year olds.

The new building by AY Architects, is designed around a flexible playspace opening onto a wooded outdoor play area. Daylight is brought into the building through strip windows located in the roof, which also provide natural ventilation.

The superstructure is constructed from KLH prefabricated solid timber panels with a white washed internal finish. The exterior of the building will be clad with dark stained FSC timber boarding and the roof supports a biodiversity sedum blanket.

### **CARBON CALCULATION**

Total stored/sequestered carbon in the KLH panels for the Montpelier Community Nursery is 11.5 tonnes
